



RFU Child Protection Guidelines CRB Disclosure Information

All HRURS members who referee U18 players must complete a Disclosure Application Form for the Criminal Records Bureau.

This ensures all our Referees comply with the [RFU Child Protection Guidelines](#).

**You will need to bring with you 3 documents,
one from Group 1
and two from Groups 1 or 2**

GROUP 1

- Valid Passport (any Nationality)
- UK Driving Licence (either photocard or paper)
- Original UK Birth Certificate (issued within 12 months of the date of birth) (full or short-form acceptable)
- Valid Photo Identity Card (EU Countries only)
- UK Firearms Licence

GROUP 2

- Marriage certificate
- Non-original UK birth certificate (issued after 12 months of date of birth) (full or short-form acceptable)
- P45/P60 statement **
- Bank or Building Society statement*
- Utility Bill *
- Valid TV Licence
- Credit Card Statement *
- Store card statement *
- Mortgage Statement **
- Valid insurance certificate
- Valid vehicle registration document
- Mail order catalogue statement *
- Valid NHS Card
- Addressed payslip *

* documentation should be less than 3 months old ** issued within past 12 months
